## Our Constitution

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the organization shall be: The Women's Club of Greater Lakeway.

ARTICLE II - Objective

The objective of the organization shall be to promote the social, cultural and intellectual growth of its members. The business of the club shall neither be conducted for profit nor shall the club as a whole, support or endorse any political cause or candidate.

ARTICLE III – Management

Section 1. – Executive Committee

The officers of the club comprising the Executive Committee shall be the President, First Vice President, Second Vice President, Recording Secretary, Corresponding Secretary and Treasurer.

Section 2. – Board of Directors

The Executive Committee together with the Standing Committee Chairmen (see By-laws, ARTICLE VII – Standing Committees), and the Parliamentarian, shall constitute the Board of Directors.

Section 3. – Parliamentarian

The retiring President shall become a non-voting member of the Board of Directors and be the Parliamentarian. She shall be responsible to ensure that the most recent revision(s) of the Constitution, By-Laws and Standing Rules are published in the yearbook/directory and on the website. See Item 3. of the Standing Rules and ARTICLE VI, Section 1. of the By-Laws for additional responsibilities.

ARTICLE IV – Annual Meeting

The Annual Meeting of the club shall be held in May.

## ARTICLE V – Amendments

The Constitution, may be amended at any General Membership meeting of the club by a simple majority vote of the members-in-good-standing who are present at the meeting, provided that the proposed amendment was submitted in writing and posted for all to review at the previous meeting.
